The Family of will try to

- ensure that he comes to school regularly, avoid taking holidays during term time and inform the school on the first day of absence;

- encourage and support him in homework and other opportunities for home learning;
- attend parent evenings to discuss his progress;
- be aware of what is happening in school;
- support the school's approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any images, video, sound or text that could upset or offend any member of the school community or bring the school name into disrepute.

The School will

- care for your child and provide an education of the highest quality based on a broad and balanced curriculum which meets the individual needs of the child;
- contact you if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment;
- let you know about any concerns or problems with your child's work or behaviour;
- provide regular information on what we aim to teach your child and arrange a parent's evening each term to discuss progress;
- provide clear policies and guidelines in all areas, including behaviour and homework, and ensure that parents are kept fully informed of expectations;
- keep you informed about school activities through regular newsletters and notices in school and offer you opportunities to become involved in the daily life of the school.
