Year 4 Cycling Skills Courses

Cycle skills courses will be run for year 4 pupils at Ickniel Walk on 18th and 19th April 2018. The cost will be £15 per child and will take place during school time.

The course will include a Highway Code theory booklet and cycling skills exercises on the playground. These will include starting and stopping safely, riding in a straight line, using their gears, controlling their cycle when looking behind and when signalling.

Children will need a bicycle of suitable size and in good working order and their own cycle helmet, a waterproof coat and gloves if it is wet or cold.

Places are limited, but we need 10 children per session to make the sessions viable, so if you wish your child to take part please complete the consent form and return it to the school as soon as possible together with a cheque for £15 (made payable to **Ickniel Walk First School**), cash or by School Gateway. We will let you know which course and dates your child will be taking part in.

I regret that we are unable to make any refunds once the course has been confirmed. The deadline for replies is **Monday 26th February**.
