


Autumn 10 - Newsletter - 13/11/2025

Supermarket vouchers for children eligible for FSMs

Hertfordshire County Council will be providing supermarket vouchers for each child entitled to benefit related free school meals for the Christmas holiday. Eligible families will receive a digital supermarket voucher to the value of £30 per eligible child.

During term time, every child in Reception, Year 1 and 2 is entitled to receive a free school meal through the Universal Infant Free School Meal scheme, however this is not covered as part of the holiday scheme. Only those nursery and infant aged children that are eligible because of benefit-related criteria will be included.

If you think your child may be eligible for free school meals but you have not yet applied please check here www.hertfordshire.gov.uk/freeschoolmeals




Tickets for the legendary Rainbow Hampers will be on sale from 20th November! There are so many chances to win a fantastic hamper full of sweets, treats and goodies.
