Message from Mrs Sherwood



This has been a busy week in school.

Yesterday we held the 'Grand Opening' of our outdoor classroom. Two leading members of the PTA cut the ribbon and all the classes visited the classroom throughout the day to have a story. We are really grateful for all the hard work and enthusiasm from the PTA, who have raised a huge amount of money to purchase the classroom. We are really looking forward to using it regularly. Thank you to governors, Nick Fisk and Rachel Page for attending too.

On Monday we had our first full governing body meeting of the year. We were sorry to see our long-time chair of governors, Kate Hackwell, step down from her role, and we have recorded our grateful thanks for all her hard work and support for the school. Kate has been involved with the school since her son joined in 2007 — we will miss her!

We are really pleased to tell you that the role of Chair of Governors will be a shared role going forward, taken on by Rachel Page and Nick Fisk, who are both very experienced governors, and we know they will support the school very effectively. We welcomed back to the board Tim Johnson as a parent governor (he has a child in year 3) and Sarah Beadle (she has a child in reception). Also joining us as a Local Authority governor is Robyn MacFayden, who leads the North Herts Primary Support Service. She will bring a lot of valuable experience and expertise to the board. At the meeting the governors discussed and approved our new School Development Plan for this academic year (see image below).

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our parents' evenings either in person or virtually. If you are coming to the in-person session (Tuesday 30th Sept), please come into the school via the carpark entrance (the long corridor leading directly to the hall). Ivy Farm Bridge (over A505) - Campaign for Right of Way

We have had a message from our Local County and District Councillors to request your help.

The councillors are working to create a public right of way over a currently closed agricultural bridge (Ivy Farm Bridge) that crosses the A505 to facilitate access between Bassingbourn and Royston for pedestrians, cyclists and horse riders.

Ivy Farm Bridge is owned by Hertfordshire County Council, which has been leading a project to create rights of way over it. Opening the bridge would mean that people in Royston could safely access more of the countryside on foot or bicycle, whilst those in Bassingbourn could access the many local facilities in Royston without needing to drive.

The councillors invite letters from people in the community who support this effort and ask that the key points below are included within their letters.

Key points

Please address your letter to: Mr Anders Holch Povlsen, Cokenach Estate

- There is no safe walking route between Bassingbourn and Royston. To walk between the two, you must run across the A505.
- Royston is the closest place to Bassingbourn for swimming and leisure, transport connections to post-16 education and training, and weekend and holiday jobs.
- There are currently no safe routes out of Royston which children and families can use to access the nearby countryside, or their friends in Bassingbourn.
- There is a bridge over the A505, the Ivy Farm Bridge, but it's against the law to access it.
- Hertfordshire County Council, who own the bridge, are trying to open this route for travel on foot, bicycle, and horseback.
- To do this, HCC need your permission to cross a small section of land on the Cokenach Estate.
- We would be so grateful for your support to help make this happen.

If you choose to write a letter in support of this, the letter can be left with the school office, for the councillors to collect in mid-October.
