## **Message from Mrs Sherwood**

Tomorrow Carmel Jane Photography will be visiting school to take individual and sibling portrait photographs throughout the school day. All children should wear their school uniform; hair accessories should be school colours and kept minimal.

Wear Yellow for World Mental Health Day - Friday 10th October 2025 - we will be having a non-uniform day and asking the children to wear something yellow, it could be as little as their socks or a hairband. The usual non-uniform day rules apply; children will need sensible shoes to allow them to move around school safely and be able to play in the playground. They will also need a coat. We are not collecting money on this occasion; it is just to raise awareness around mental health to support children's wellbeing on World Mental Health Day.

- 2.30pm on Sunday 5th October at Icknield Walk First School £15 per child (adults go free) all proceeds will go to the PTA.




