### **Message from Mrs Sherwood**

Tomorrow is *Wear Yellow for World Mental Health Day.* We will be having a non-uniform day and asking the children to wear something yellow, it could be as little as their socks or a hairband. The usual non-uniform day rules apply; children will need sensible shoes to allow them to move around school safely and be able to play in the playground. They will also need a coat. We are not collecting money on this occasion; it is just to raise awareness around mental health to support children's wellbeing on World Mental Health Day.



Royston Fire Station are taking part in an initiative in Hertfordshire which is called 'Coats4Kids'.
