What is an outsider? Someone who feels left out, who feels like they don't belong or not welcome. At Icknield Walk First school we believe no one should feel like an outsider because at our school everyone is welcome! With the help of the No Outsiders charity, we ensure that children move through school exploring and celebrating difference whilst feeling proud of who they are.

How do we achieve this?

Our aim is to ensure that as children begin their journey at Icknield Walk First School they are taught to celebrate and embrace differences. Our ethos is backed up by the language and behaviour promoted throughout the school. From the early years to year 4, we read books recommended by the No Outsiders charity that provide opportunities for discussions and activities to explore difference, prejudice and discrimination. Unfortunately, it is likely that all children will experience this at some point in their life.

The children will recognise many of the popular authors, who have been carefully chosen to take your child on a journey, where they will meet a variety of different characters representing a world full of diversity.
