Photographs and Videos filmed at School events

Please remember that photographs and videos that are filmed at school events (sports day, assemblies, performances) by parents and carers, should NOT be shared on social media or outside of your family, this is because some of our children are very vulnerable. Some schools have introduced a no photograph and filming policy, which means parents/carers are not allowed to take photographs or videos of their children at school events at all, we do not want to have to do the same. Please be considerate of the reasons why we ask you to only share your photographs and videos with family and not on social media or outside of your family.

Uniform for the new school year

Sun Protection Procedures

- Everyone needs a named water bottle in school - every day.
- All children need a named hat to wear when outside in the sunshine (these can be purchased from Schoolyard or local supermarkets).
- Children need their own named sunscreen which should be given to the class teacher and kept in school. Sun sticks or roll on sunscreens can be easier for the children to handle themselves. Please practise with your child to help them apply their own sunscreen as the staff are not allowed to rub in sun screens and children are not allowed to rub them on each other.
- We do not encourage the use of sunglasses, however if you wish for your child to wear them at playtime because they have hay fever, please make sure they are named. If your child does wear sunglasses, we will encourage them to choose a quiet activity at playtime.

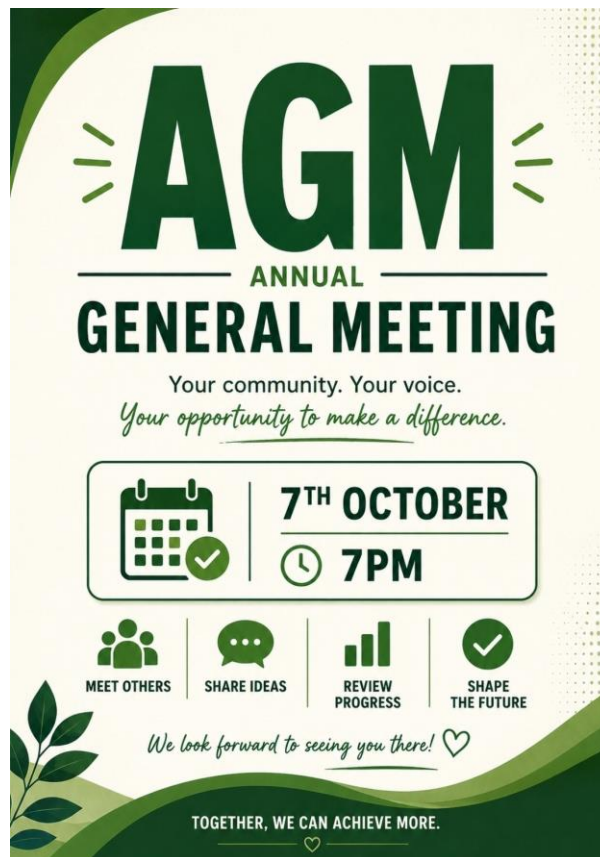
Save the date for the **AGM - 7th October!**
