Sports Days

Our **sports day** for KS1 (Years 1&2) and KS2 (Years 3&4) will take place on **Wednesday (26th June)**. The event will start at 9.30am on the school field, please drop your child to their classroom as usual. They will need their trainers, white t-shirt and black shorts, which Years 3 & 4 will change into on arrival. Years 1 & 2, should come into school wearing their PE kit and bring their uniform with them to school. After the event, all the children will change back into their school uniform. Please ensure before coming to school that sun cream is applied. Children will also need a sun hat and a full bottle of water.

Our Reception sports day will take place on **Wednesday 10th July**. The event will start at 9.30am on the school field. Children should arrive at school in their PE kit (white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers), children will change into their school uniform afterwards so please ensure that they have their uniform with them when they are dropped off at school.

The PTA will be selling tea, coffee, refreshments from 8.45am to 9.20am in the dining hall on both dates. Please enter via the entrance next to the car park. Please remember the volunteers are parents too, they will need to close at 9.20am to enable them to watch their own children.

Please note, on both sports days the gates will be closed at 9.30am and will not be opened again until the sports events have finished.

Parents and carers are welcome to take photographs/videos on the sports days but these must remain for personal use only and must not be shared on social media.

Non school uniform day - Friday 28th June

The children may come to school in non uniform, in return for bringing a bottle for the Summer Fair bottle tombola. Bottles can be anything such as squash, wine, beer, condiments etc. Class teachers will take the bottles from you at the classroom door. As always when the children come in non-uniform please make sure the children have sensible shoes and clothes that are appropriate for school.
